- A CD or flash drive with up to ten images of recent work. *WSW reserves the right not to review applications that are not formatted properly.*
- Image script, which should include the title, medium, dimension, and date of each image. (3 hard copies)
- A structural dummy to demonstrate how the book will be bound or function when handled. This does not have to be a complete representation of the finished piece. Please do, however, include at least 1-2 fully realized spreads. Your dummy should represent the book's actual size. We do, of course, anticipate that you will refine your ideas before the residency begins. (1 hard copy)
- Applicants who don't want to be notified by email can include a self-addressed, stamped envelope
- Please note:** application materials will not be returned unless requested. In this case, adequate postage and packaging material must be included with the application. Please *talk* to your post office about this, as there are certain types of postage that expire.
