Found my self feeling better! the wall paper is done!







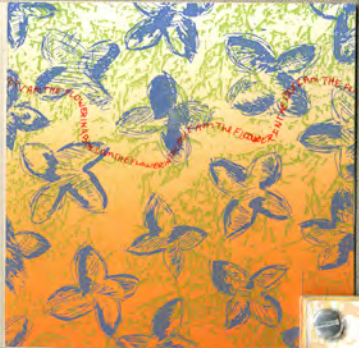















... through these
