This book is our reflection on the world we're living in today. Ann has long been intrigued by odd/uncommon words. The selection of words, inspired by *Wordsmith.com*, seems especially timely as each one depicts the characteristics of the orgiastic showcase of power, regardless of basic human goodness.

Our current times made Tatana think of Karel Čapek's visionary play R.U.R. (Rossum's Universal Robots), written over a century ago, yet somehow attuned to this moment. In Čapek's world, artificial people—roboti, meaning forced laborers, are engineered for tireless productivity and expendable use.

The linear text of offering a glimpse of hope was written by Tatana, and is not unlike the conclusion in R.U.R. when the society revolts and the evil in their world collapses.
